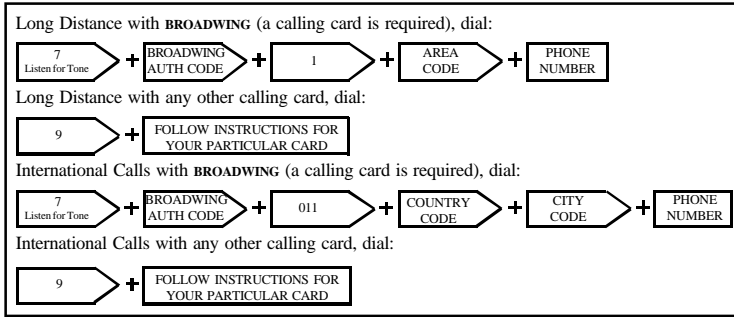

NOTRE DAME STUDENT LONG DISTANCE



•**Outgoing**- Long distance calls may not be charged to any dormitory phone number. A penalty of \$10 will be assessed for each occurrence.

•**Incoming**- Long distance collect calls are not to be accepted on any dormitory phone number. A penalty of \$10 will be assessed for each occurrence.

•A calling card is required to make long distance and international calls from a dormitory telephone. Students may subscribe to discounted long distance service which is provided by Broadwing Communications. If you wish to sign up for this service, call Broadwing's campus office at 634-4150 or Broadwing Customer Service at 1-800-735-1213.

AREA CODES AND TIME ZONES

INTERNATIONAL CALLING

Calls to the Bahamas, Bermuda, Canada, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and the West Indies are considered long distance, not international calls.

To obtain foreign country and city codes not listed and any special instructions, dial "00" (zero-zero) to reach your long distance company.

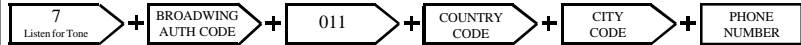
HOW TO MAKE DIRECT-DIAL CALLS

ND Faculty and Staff 631-CENTREX, dial:



Wait at least 45 seconds for ringing to start.

ND Student Dormitory 634-CENTREX (a calling card is required), dial:



TO MAKE OPERATOR ASSISTED CALLS

ND Faculty and Staff 631-CENTREX: call the campus operator for instructions on making international person-to-person, collect, calling card and third-number calls.

ND Student Dormitory 634-CENTREX (a calling card is required), dial:

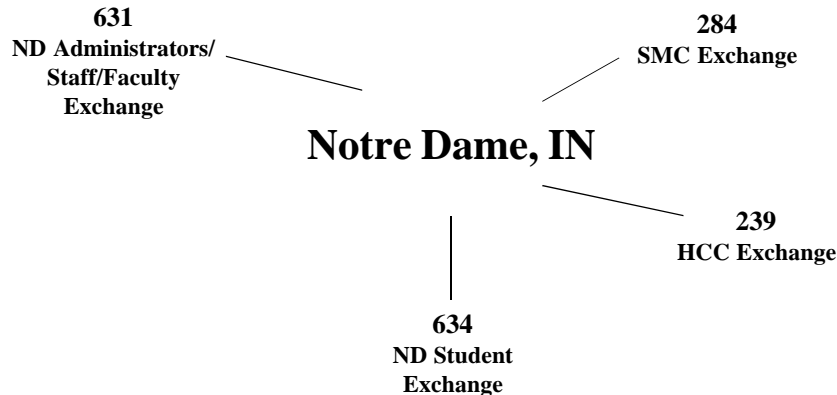

Notre Dame produces one telephone bill per calendar month. The new billing cycle changes on the 10th day of each month.

TTY TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SYSTEM

The TTY designation next to a student's phone number means that the student has a hearing impairment and cannot use a standard telephone. However, you can still talk to them by using the Indiana Telecommunications Relay service. This free service makes it easy to contact a deaf or hard of hearing student by telephone. When you call the relay number listed below the operator will ask you the number you are calling. The operator will then call the person using a teletypewriter (TTY). The TTY looks like a small computer with a keyboard and a display. Individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing use TTY's to read and type over the phone instead of listening and speaking. The operator will type everything you say and send it to the deaf individual's TTY. The individual who is deaf will read your message and respond by typing a message that the operator will read to you. The service is free. Calls are private and no records are kept. The operator is strictly an interpreter. You can talk as long as you wish and you can call seven days a week, 24 hours a day.

TORNADO/SAFETY INFORMATION

TORNADO “WEATHER” is an atmospheric condition typified by hot, humid days, southerly winds and darkening skies. Huge greenish-black thunderclouds usually appear an hour or two before tornadoes form. Rain, and frequently hail, precede and follow tornadoes. The time of greatest frequency is between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. When close by, tornadoes sound like the roar of jet planes at takeoff.

A TORNADO IS RECOGNIZABLE by the funnel-shaped cloud which appears from the southwest and travels at about 30 miles per hour. It spins rapidly (with whirling winds which exceed 300 miles per hour on the perimeter) and extends toward the earth from the base of a thundercloud. When it touches down, it is often 300 yards wide. Its destructive force results from the speed of its exterior winds and the vacuum in its interior which creates large differences in air pressure.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WATCH means that damaging winds and hail are expected. It often precedes the issuance of a Tornado Watch. **A TORNADO WATCH** means that conditions are favorable for the development of tornadoes. (**WATCHES** may be issued frequently. Except for keeping informed via radio or television, they **do not** require immediate action.)

A tornado warning requires immediate action, because a tornado has been sighted, either visually or on radar and Notre Dame is in its path!



SAFETY RULES

A tornado warning is issued when a tornado has been sighted, either visually or on radar, and Notre Dame is in its path! The St. Joseph County Civil Defense **Tornado Warning** system will activate the siren atop the North Dining Hall. For tornadoes, the siren will issue a **steady tone** for three to five minutes.

(A warning sound indicates an enemy attack — it is **not** an all clear.) The siren will **not** issue an “all clear.” The signal comes from the Weather Bureau via radio or television.

SIREN TESTS are made at 11:30 a.m. on the first and third Thursdays of the month. They consist of a one-minute steady tone, one minute of silence and a one-minute wailing tone.

- 1. Take shelter in the nearest substantial building immediately.**
- 2. Go to the basement or to an interior corridor.**
- 3. Avoid windows, large rooms, auditoriums or gymnasiums.**
- 4. Listen to local radio for “All Clear” indication.**
